Horizon High School's Redleaf Accepted to Stanford's Summer Engineering Institute

Horizon High School recently announced that Adam Redleaf has been accepted to Stanford University's Summer Engineering Institute, one of the programs offered by Stanford through its EPGY Summer Institutes.

The EPGY (Education Program for Gifted Youth) Summer Institutes are two-to-four week residential programs for academically talented and motivated middle and high school students. The summer institutes focus on single intensive-study courses taught by Stanford faculty. Past EPGY Summer Institutes participants have come from 60 countries and 49 states.

The selection process included submitting a full transcript, completing a standardized test in math and physics developed for the engineering program Redleaf applied for, and three recommendations from his teachers. The program also inquired about extracurricular activities, leadership roles, and overall citizenship roles.
