Horizon High School Hosts 11th Annual Basketball Invitational

Horizon High School and the Husky Hoops Club will host the 2011 Horizon Invitational Basketball Tournament, sponsored by Embassy Suites. The tournament will be held on December 14, 16, and 17 and features seven local boys Varsity High School teams and one team from Canada . All games will be played in Horizon's gymnasium at 56th Street and Greenway Road .

The games begin Wednesday at 3:00 p.m. and wrap up with the championship game Saturday at 6:00 p.m. The participating teams are Horizon, Robert Bateman Secondary (Canada), Deer Valley, Fountain Hills, Centennial, Coronado, Mountain Pointe and Marcos de Niza.

Admission is \$7 per day for adults, \$3 for High School students with ID, \$1 for Middle and Elementary School ages, and children age 6 and under are free. Admission to the tournament includes a game day program and entry into all halftime and daily prize drawings.

The featured prizes include a weekend stay from Embassy Suites located in Paradise Valley , an iPad from APS, day passes to AZ Air Time's indoor trampoline jump center, Rockford Fosgate merchandise, and concert tickets given out by KISS FM.

KISS FM 104.7 will be also be on-site promoting "High School Hoops" on Friday, December 16. "High School Hoops" is a student drug prevention program focused on educating teens and parents on staying off drugs and what to look out for. Maricopa County Attorney, Bill Montgomery, has asked KISS FM to support this program on-air and on-site at different games throughout the basketball season. Students are encouraged to sign the pledge to stay drug-free upon entering the game and will be entered to win an iPad from APS at halftime of the last Horizon Invitational game on Friday. KISS FM will have music and entertainment from on-air DJ Aaron Taylor, who will call into the station to promote the game and the program.
