**PAWS (Horizon High School Boosters, Inc.) welcomes you to the 2010-2011 school year.**

**When you think Horizon High School, you might think neighborhood school, easy to get to, great academics, great teachers, and great sports and fine arts programs. Horizon is even more than this. We are a community.**

**What is PAWS and how does it help make Horizon High School great?**

**PAWS works to build and keep our community in tact.** We encourage supportive relationships with the Administration and Faculty, Fine Arts and Sports programs, and School Clubs.

This past school year,

- **PAWS awarded \$6,000.00** in post high school scholarships to graduating seniors.
- **Granted over \$8,000.00** to our school as follows: \$2,500.00 to the Athletic department for a speaker, \$2,900.00 for the Science Department to buy "frictionless tracks" for use in Physics classes, \$500.00 for ACCENTS to "spruce up" the area outside the Auditorium, \$600.00 for StuGo for their teacher appreciation breakfasts, \$265.00 for the Special Education Department to buy calculators for their students, \$797.00 to the Science and Math departments for their "Bring Geometry to Life Program" and over \$500.00 combined to the Counseling Dept., Tri-M Music Honor Society club and to VOTE YES for PV schools.
- Supported Horizon families facing hardships.
- Hosted the premier graduation party, Grad Nite 2010 at Dave and Buster's and **donated \$5,000.00 to the event.**
- Hosted the first annual **"ALL SCHOOL GARAGE SALE"** which **earned our groups over \$12,000.00** and hosted the Warehouse sale giving our groups \$4,160.00 for their time worked.
- **Won \$1,000.00** for the Athletic Department by participating in the Valley Chevy dealer contest.

**PAWS is a non-profit organization**, funded through annual memberships, proceeds raised by working in the cafeteria during lunchtime, and participation in Safeway E-scrip, Fry's cool Cash and Albertson's Community Partners programs.

**PAWS-PTO creates** a school directory that lists "safe homes", sponsors teacher appreciation breakfasts and luncheons, and arranges for several outstanding awareness and prevention programs throughout the year. They also offer many opportunities for parents to get involved on campus through their volunteer network.
