\$ 6k in Scholarships: Towards the end of each school year, PAWS awards 6 seniors, each with a \$ 1000.00

scholarship to use for college expenses. The seniors write an essay on the following categories: Academics, Athletics, Comeback, Community Service, Fine Arts and Pride.

These essays are submitted anonymously to all of our board members. We read them and vote on them individually. The highest number of votes in each category receives the scholarship. This year we also will be adding scholarships for our Special Education

Students.

Grants: Our Grants program is available to any one of our sports and booster clubs mentioned

above. Our Grants program allows these clubs to request for items in which they have fundraised for but need that last extra help to accomplish the task. Some of the items PAWS has assisted with in the last several years include: new library carts, padding for the fences on the baseball field, repaired 17 orchestra instruments, and shade structures

for the tennis courts.

Wish Lists for Teachers: Every quarter throughout the year, PAWS asks every teacher, administration and staff at

Horizon High School, what they need. The school was very appreciative of this and we are honored to be able to provide this support. Here are some of the items we will be purchasing: pencil sharpeners, rulers, protractors, yardsticks, science and biology supplies,

art supplies, fans for the hallways, just to name a few.

<u>School Grounds:</u> Over the next year, PAWS board members will be working all year to improve school
