Dear Members of PAWS,

The sponsors and advocates of student leadership on the Horizon High School campus, Jason Jones and Amber Strang, are currently seeking a grant of \$2,500 to help fund the leadership and learning opportunity known as Camp Gold. The objective of the camp is to build leadership skills and allow future leaders to tear down stereotypes, gain a better understanding of who they are and would like to be, and become a team that will work together to make Horizon, and the world beyond, a better place. As a direct result of this opportunity and what these students learn, they are able to lead in a direction that puts aside bias and hate and embraces humanity with patience and acceptance. The impact of this camp extends far beyond the wall of the campus and fosters a future that is hopeful and bright for our country and our world.

Camp Gold is a leadership retreat for current juniors led by current seniors, who serve as the camp counselors. Eden Wininger, a current senior at HHS, describes Camp Gold as "empowering, eye-opening, and community". Last year this incredible program successfully took 52 students to Prescott for 3 days and changed their lives. The results were beyond what was ever imagined. Those who attended Camp Gold went on to be leaders at Husky Camp in the summer of 2016. The connection between the two programs allowed for the impact of the camp to reach not only those who attended Camp Gold, but in a measurable and meaningful way, it impacted 350 students in the incoming Freshman class as well. That is a result worth the cost and worthy of continuance.

Based on last year's expenses with an increase in camp participants this year, from the original 52 to 58, the current budget is \$13,146. Each student will pay \$100 to attend, which leaves a remaining balance of \$7,346. The undeniable impact of the camp on student perceptions, leadership, and attitudes make the cost more than worth it. Declan Kinnane, a current senior at HHS, says, "Camp Gold helped me come out of my shell and become friends with people I probably would have never met otherwise. I learned how to be more confident and have a deeper understanding of what it takes to be a leader not just at Horizon but also in the community." With the financial assistance of your organization, Camp Gold 2017 can be a reality.

District has approved the dates of March 23-26 for us to host camp again in Prescott . We are currently reaching out to Horizon's Student Government to help us with the expenses as well as brainstorming ideas for fundraising. The grant request of \$2,500 from your organization would pay for the Charter Bus which is \$1,400 and help cover the facility cost of staying at the campsite. We are hoping to find other ways to raise the rest of the money as we are incredibly passionate about continuing this worthwhile program at Horizon High School.

If you have any questions regarding Camp Gold we would be more than happy to answer them. We truly thank you for your time and consideration of this grant proposal.
